



Dear Parent;


The bizarre and spine chilling incident has indeed sent shock waves across Delhi and NCR schools. As already shared with you, we at DPSG PV, are reviewing our security and safety measures. We would like to enforce following safety measures in the school with immediate effect.

- The school gate will only be opened at 7.15 a.m. for regular school. Students will have to reach school at 7:25 am and all gates will be closed by 7:30 am sharp. All children, who are not staying for afternoon classes must leave the school premises at 2.45 p.m.
- Parents are requested to collect the children by 2:40 pm sharp. Nobody will be allowed to enter the school premises after 2:45 pm.
- School bus drivers and conductors will not be allowed to enter the school building.
- Parents/guardians/visitors will not be allowed inside school during school hours, unless they have a prior appointment with a member of the staff. The visitors, on entry, will be issued a Visitor's Pass and an entry slip which will have to be duly signed by the staff member and returned at the gate at the time of exit. Parents are requested to carry some identity proof with them at all times.
- Do not send your ward to school if he/she is feeling unwell. A proper application or Medical leave must be submitted in writing by the parents. Once the child has come to the school, parents are not permitted to take him/her back home during school hours unless there is a major emergency. In such cases, the permission of the Coordinator/Headmistress/Principal is mandatory.
- Parents can meet the teachers between 7:30 am to 8:30 am with prior appointment.
- Primary gate (Gate No.4) will be permanently closed w.e.f. 21st September 2017. Walkers will use gate No. 1 and gate No.3 for entry and exit purpose.
- To uphold the safety and security of the children, the school does not permit the use of two wheelers.
- The school forbids commuting by private vans as it is unsafe for the students. For all safety and security purposes we encourage the use of school transport.
- Students cannot change bus routes or bus stop without prior permission of the transport in-charge.
- Parents are requested to review / update their address and mobile numbers in student profile through parent login.
- Parents are requested to fill in the particulars of the Parents' card attached at the back of the almanac and to carry the card whenever they come to school.

We also request parents to be careful while using social media, especially when sharing messages and pictures. We need to be responsible users of the social media space and teach our children the same. The parent community has always supported the school and we will be happy to take suggestions from parents.
